Unsure about upgrading?

To help your customers determine if Windows 11 is right for them, have them download the PC Health Check App. When the app launches they can select **Check now** to begin the scan to find out if their device qualifies.

They'll see one of three results:

It's still possible...

If they've received the yellow exclamation mark, it's possible their device could still qualify. They may need to make some adjustments however.

Some <u>potential issues</u> could include removing external hardware, updating Windows, uninstalling non-Microsoft antivirus software, uninstalling nonessential software, and freeing up disk space.
