


Top 10 reasons your customers should have a Microsoft account

Required for most Windows 11 devices


A Microsoft account is required to set up your new **Windows 11 home edition device** as well as the ability to download and take advantage of some features in the new OS.

If **upgrading a device from Windows 10**, you will also need to use your Microsoft account. For customers who would like to use a local account, they'll need to purchase a Windows 11 Pro edition device.









Manage your family's digital safety

Manage and monitor your children's digital life with great apps like <u>Microsoft Family Safety</u>. You can <u>set screen time limits</u> on their devices and set up **content filters** that create a space for kids to explore appropriate apps and games.

And with <u>activity reporting</u>, you're able to view your children's activities on **Windows**, **Xbox**, and **Android** devices. You can even see their search activity when they search with **Bing**.







Sync your Android phone and PC

Get **instant access** to your phone's photos, texts, and more on your computer. Just snap a pic on your Android and see it on your PC. With the **Microsoft Phone Link app**, easily **text your friends**, send **group messages**, and type with a keyboard—all from your PC.

And with your 5 GB of free OneDrive cloud storage (1 TB with a Microsoft 365 subscription), get access to all your photos remotely from any computer—even if something happens to your device.

You'll need a Microsoft account to **connect to Xbox-enabled devices**, **play games on Game Pass**, and access exciting features like **cloud gaming** on your Xbox, Windows PC, or mobile device.

Use it to **connect with friends** on the Xbox app, and to **update your profile**, gamertag, or avatar. You'll also need it to update your personal Xbox settings, or to **manage children's gaming habits** with the Xbox Family Settings app.

Anyone with a Microsoft account has access to the free, basic version of Microsoft Teams.* Use it to stay in touch with friends and family with unlimited chat and unlimited group meetings for up to 60 minutes.

Have a big group? No big deal. You can message and video chat with up to **100 participants** per meeting, then store your pictures and notes. Plus, share files and tasks with **5 free GB of cloud storage** per user.

To turn on or off the **Find my device** setting, just go to **Start** and type **Find my device**.










